Fire Sprinkler Inspection

Using full time trained and licensed professionals who perform inspections and sprinkler system maintenance on a daily basis, Dalmatian Fire offers NFPA 25 monthly visual inspections, quarterly sprinkler inspections, annual sprinkler inspections, 5-year sprinkler internal pipe inspections, fire pump testing and inspection, hydrant inspection and testing, and backflow preventer testing.

Fire Sprinkler Repair & Maintenance

Dalmatian Fire offers 24-hour service and can handle all fire sprinkler system part orders, repair requests, and maintenance needs. Whether replacing sprinkler heads in fire systems or servicing fire sprinkler water storage tanks, Dalmatian Fire can address all these issues and more.

Backflow Preventer Testing

An unused backflow preventer valve that is not operated periodically may not open when clients need it most. Virtually all sprinkler systems that tie into city water supplies have backflow preventers installed today. The various types of backflow preventer valves and assemblies used are: double check valve assemblies (DCVA), double detector check valve assemblies (DDCVA or DCDVA), reduced pressure zone assemblies (RPZ or RPZA), and reduced pressure detector zone assemblies (RPZDA).

It is a code requirement to have certified backflow testers perform these tests. Dalmatian Fire's inspectors are ALL certified backflow testers and are thoroughly knowledgeable of state standards and codes, including Indiana, Ohio and Kentucky fire codes.
